India to host International Congress of Mathematics in 2010

December 26, 2008

New Delhi: The International Congress of Mathematics (ICM) will be held at Hyderabad between August 19 and 27 in 2010. The ICM is an event of unique significance to the mathematical community around the world.

The conference is held once every four years. This is for the first time the event will be organized in India and only the third time in Asia after Kyoto (1990) and Beijing (2002).

The congress will be held at the Hyderabad International Convention Centre (HICC).

The logo of the ICM contains a Sanskrit quotation taken from the Rig Veda. India has been selected as the venue by the International Mathematical Union (IMU) to organize the ICM.
